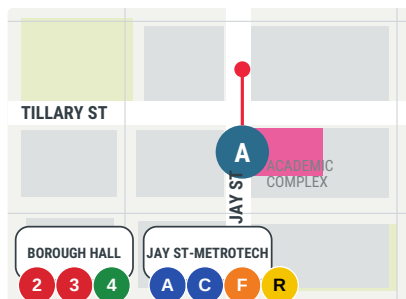
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DIRECTIONS ON HOW TO GET TO

The Theater at City Tech

Academic Complex - Jay Street entrance



BY SUBWAY:

A, C, F or R: Get off at Jay St-MetroTech and walk north on Jay Street toward Tillary Street. 2, 3, 4 or 5: Get off at Borough Hall and walk east toward Jay Street. The Theater is in City Tech's Academic Complex at 285 Jay Street.



BY BUS:

Current MTA routes serving the City Tech / Downtown Brooklyn area include B25, B26, B38, B41, B52, B57, B62, B67, B69 and B103 LTD. Routes and stops can change; check MTA service before departure.



BY CAR:

From Manhattan and the Bronx:

Take the FDR Drive to the Brooklyn Bridge. Stay left when exiting the bridge, turn left onto Tillary Street, then turn right onto Jay Street at the first traffic light.

From Queens:

Take the Long Island Expressway west to the BQE / I-278 toward Downtown Brooklyn. Exit at Tillary Street; continue past the Flatbush Avenue Extension, move left, and turn left onto Jay Street.

From Brooklyn and Staten Island:

Use I-278 / the BQE toward Downtown Brooklyn and take the Atlantic Avenue exit. Turn right on Atlantic Avenue, left on Smith Street, and continue north across Fulton Street, where Smith becomes Jay Street. From Staten Island, first take the Verrazzano-Narrows Bridge to I-278.



SCHOOL BUS & PARKING:

School buses: City Tech's public directions do not publish a dedicated school-bus drop-off or staging location. Use the event-specific arrival instructions supplied by AOSNY / the venue and do not assume curbside bus parking is permitted.

Parking: City Tech directs drivers to nearby commercial garages. Current nearby options include garages at 333 Adams Street and 351 Jay Street. Rates, hours, entrances and availability can change.
